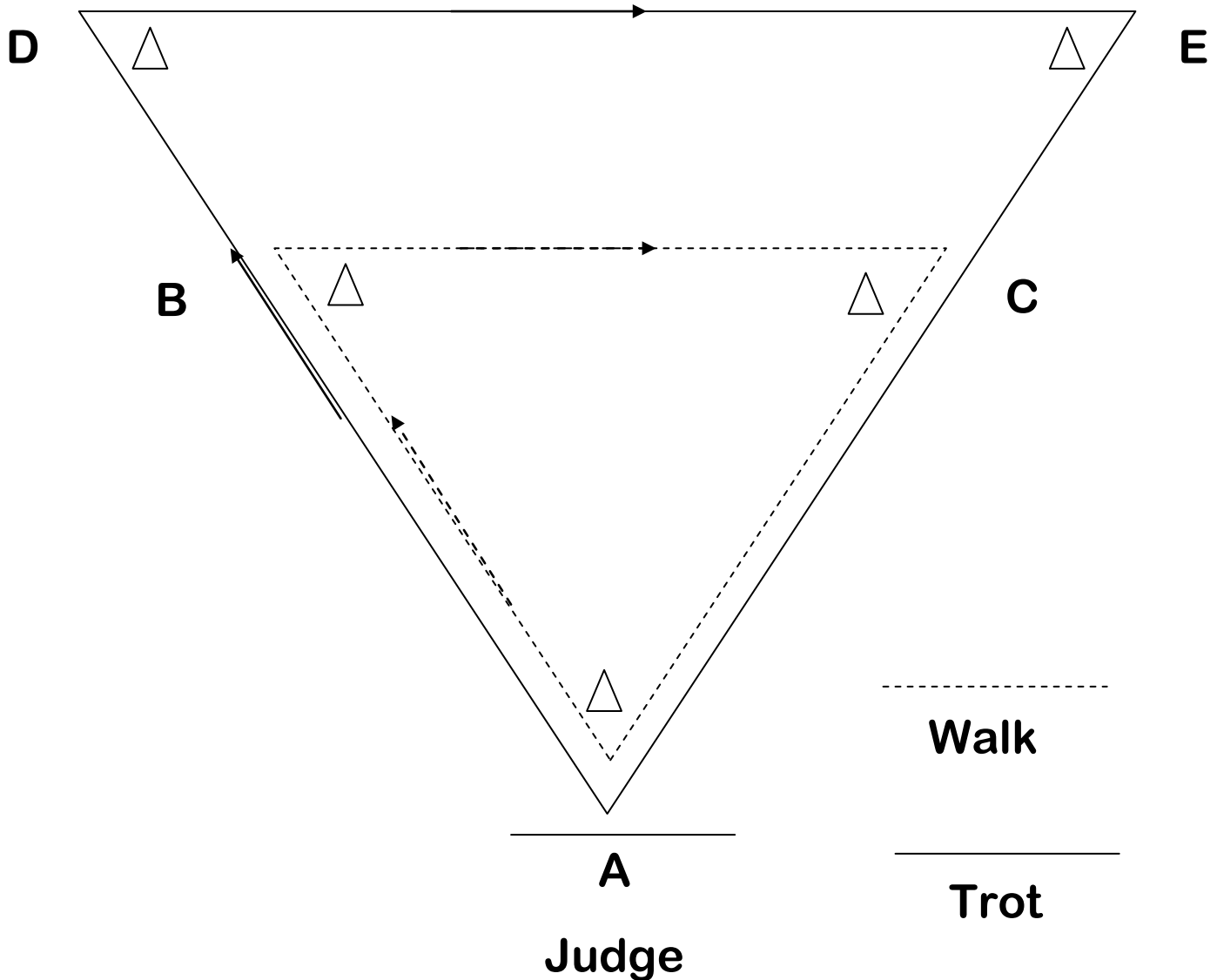


## Hunter In Hand



1. Approach the judging area (A) and set up for inspection in the “open” position (i.e. with all four legs of the horse visible by the judge standing on either side of the horse).
2. The judge shall inspect each horse from the front, rear and both sides. Transmissible weakness and/or conditions shall be counted strongly against animals
3. At the judge’s request, the horse will then walk the small triangle ABCA.
4. The horse will continue on at a trot following the large ADEA.
5. At the completion of the judging, the handler will lead the horse away from the judging area.
6. As one horse leaves, the next one will enter the judging area promptly.
